Rent of the racetrack for a minimum of 16 and max. 36 motorcycles, including police authorizations, ambulance, doctor, 4 marshalls and tow services.

Cocktail dinner at Santa Barbara castle (moslem-medievel style)

Total price for a minimum of 40 pax: 24.000 euro (VAT 16% not included)
