



The leacher sources two presentations for an example of an effective presentation and an example of a not so effective presentation. The leacher prepares some questions about the

- The visual aids the presenter uses should be : legible, appropriate, accurate
- meaning tal and interesting.

 The presenter should use a good vocal lone, deliver all an appropriate pace, speal
- with clarify, be expressive, and talk at an appropriate volume The presenter should portray correct pronunctation, grammar and sociabulary.
- The presenter's body language should ensure that eye contact is made with the quillaysa, heiste uses appropriate facial expression, get kies, and por kire. The content of the presentation should include an introduction, a logical main body and an appropriate close.

The leacher explains the applying, the students watch the two oral presentations and then the leacher asks questions about the effectiveness of the presentations. Group it will answer the questions about the first presentation and group 2 will answer the queries about the second one. The groups will decide which is the most effective presentation and a student from group will report to the rest of the class.

The leacher will take notes of the sixtents who have participated. Since the aim is to develop fluency, sixtents' mistakes will not be taken into account.


